

Peering Policy

Euro-Information Telecom is providing fixed and mobile telephony and internet access services in France to customers, companies and MVNOs under a number of brands: Crédit Mutuel Mobile, CIC Mobile, NRJ Mobile, Auchan Telecom, Cdiscount Mobile etc.

Euro-Information Telecom has a selective peering policy. Peers are selected based on the amount of traffic exchanged with Euro-Information Telecom, capability and mutual benefit for both networks. Meeting the peering guidelines presented in this policy is not a guarantee that a peering relationship with Euro-Information Telecom will be established. Euro-Information Telecom shall evaluate a number of business factors and reserves the right not to enter into a peering agreement with an applicant.

General requirements for peering with Euro-Information Telecom

- The Peer must be registered in a public Internet Routing Registry (IRR) database.
 - Its record must be completed in PeeringDB
- The Peer must have a publicly routable ASN
- The BGP session must be established in public IPv4 or IPv6
- The Peer should have a 24x7 NOC with BGP expertise

Traffic Requirements for private peering

Starting from 20 Gbps, Euro-Information Telecom invites you to contact us to build together the terms of a private network interconnection (PNI) agreement.

The PNI is free of charge up to 100Gbps of capacity. Above this value, please contact us for more details.

For symmetric or unbalance traffic (between ingress and egress) up to a ratio of 2-to-1, the peering is free regardless of the amount of traffic.

Physical interconnection must be established either in 10 Gigabits Ethernet (10GbE LR) or in 100 Gigabits Ethernet (100GbE LR).

The Peer shall not send unsolicited traffic to ASN25117.

Euro-Information Telecom shall not be liable for any damages of any nature suffered by any peer or any third party resulting in whole or in part from Euro-Information Telecom's exercise of its rights under this Peering Policy.
